Questions & Answers for the EP/SBEP/0324 - Call for Proposals

1. How are the project Technology Readiness Levels (TRLs) defined?

The definitions of TRLs are those adopted by the EU.

- TRL 1 basic principles observed
- TRL 2 technology concept formulated
- TRL 3 experimental proof of concept
- TRL 4 technology validated in lab
- TRL 5 technology validated in relevant environment
- TRL 6 technology demonstrated in relevant environment
- TRL 7 system prototype demonstration in operational environment
- TRL 8 system complete and qualified

TRL 9 - actual system proven in operational environment (competitive manufacturing in the case of key enabling technologies)

The activities described in each proposal must be compatible with the TRLs allowed by the Call (which in this case are TRLs 1-8).

2. Is there a maximum number of organisations for the Cypriot Consortium?

Yes. The maximum number of organisations in the Cypriot Consortium should be between one to three (1-3).

3. Are large Enterprises allowed to participate in the Cypriot Consortium?

The participation of Large Enterprises is only permitted when an SME is also participating in the Cypriot Consortium.

4. How the aid intensity is calculated for the participants?

Aid Intensity is calculated separately for each organisation and according to the type of activity (please view the relevant Table for the calculations of the Aid Intensity in Chapter «3.2. MAXIMUM AID INTENSITY» of the <u>RESTART 2016-2020 Work Programme</u>).
